Getting Here / Accessibility
by public transport
Tram stop Löwenbräu (tram lines 50, 51 or 17).

-   The closest public transport stop, Löwenbräu tram stop, is barrier-free for visitors with limited mobility. With the ZürichCard, travel to Löwenbräukunst with all public transport is free of charge.
-   A staircase with 14 steps leads to the Löwenbräukunst main entrance (Limmatstrasse 270). The barrier-free entrance is at Limmatstrasse 268 (Elevator, Level C). All levels of the building are accessible by lift and all the galleries are wheelchair accessible.
-   Limited parking including two disabled parking spaces is available in the courtyard of the Löwenbräukunst Areal.
